

Wanta Fanta Block

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Finished Block Measures 12" x 12" (12-1/2" x 12-1/2" with seam allowances)

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Printing the Templates

- Print two copies of page 7 at 100% and then cut the templates out along the gray seam allowance line. You will have a total of 8 templates.

Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric:

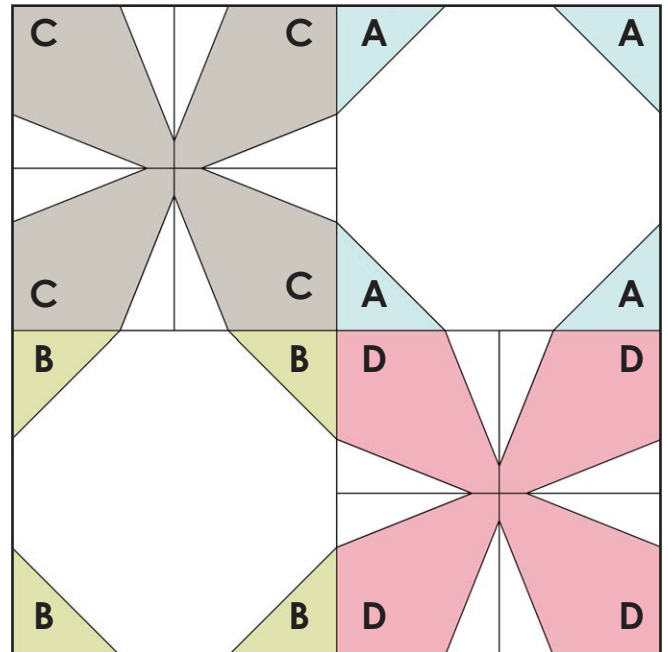
- 2 squares 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"
- 16 rectangles 2" x 4"

Fabric A & B:

- 4 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

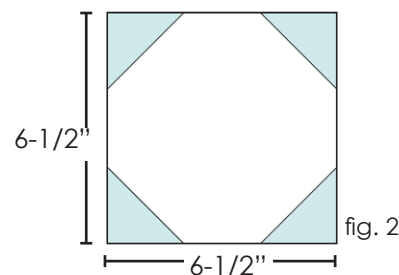
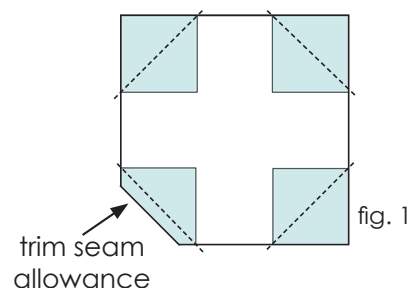
Fabric C & D:

- 4 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"



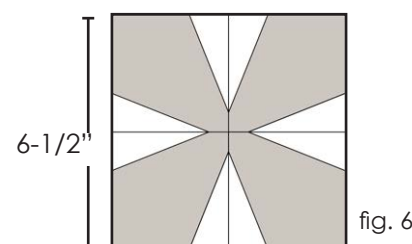
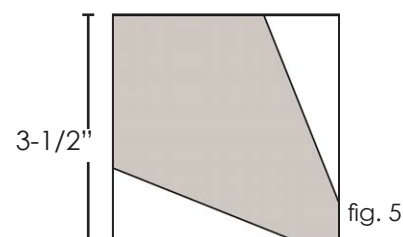
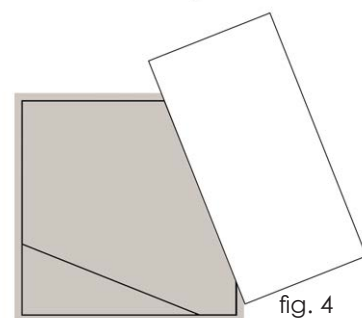
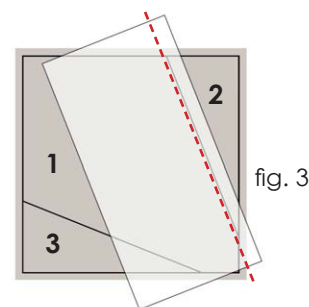
Make the Snowball Units

1. Place a 2-1/2" Fabric A square in each corner of a 6-1/2" background square, with right sides together.
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner, as pictured and then sew along the drawn line (fig. 1).
3. Trim seam allowances to 1/4", then flip the Fabric A triangles and press them flat (fig. 2). Block should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
4. Repeat steps 1-3 with the Fabric B squares and the remaining 6-1/2" background square, to make a second unit.



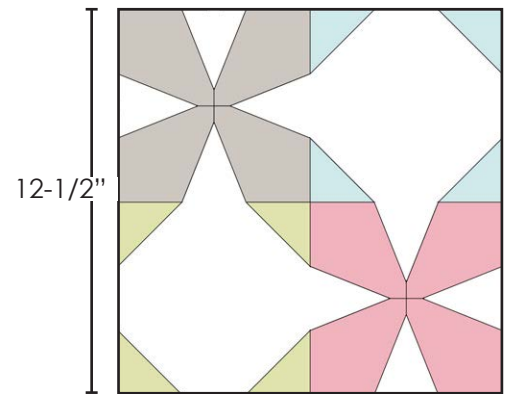
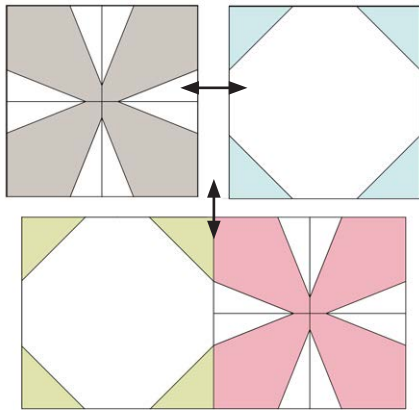
Make the X Units

1. Place a Fabric C 3-1/2" square, right side up, on the unprinted side of a template.
2. Place a 2" x 4" background rectangle, right sides together, on the Fabric C square, so that it is at least 1/4" over the line between space 1 and 2 (be sure that the rectangle will completely cover space 2 once sewn and pressed.)
3. Sew along the line with a small stitch length and backstitch in the seam allowances (fig. 3).
4. Trim seam allowance to 1/4", without trimming the paper. Flip and press flat (fig. 4).
5. Repeat steps 2-4 to sew a background rectangle which will cover space 3. Trim unit along the outer seam allowance line. (fig. 5). Unit will measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".
6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make a total of 4 units and then sew the units together to make an X unit (fig. 6). Unit will measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
7. Make a second X unit using the Fabric D squares.



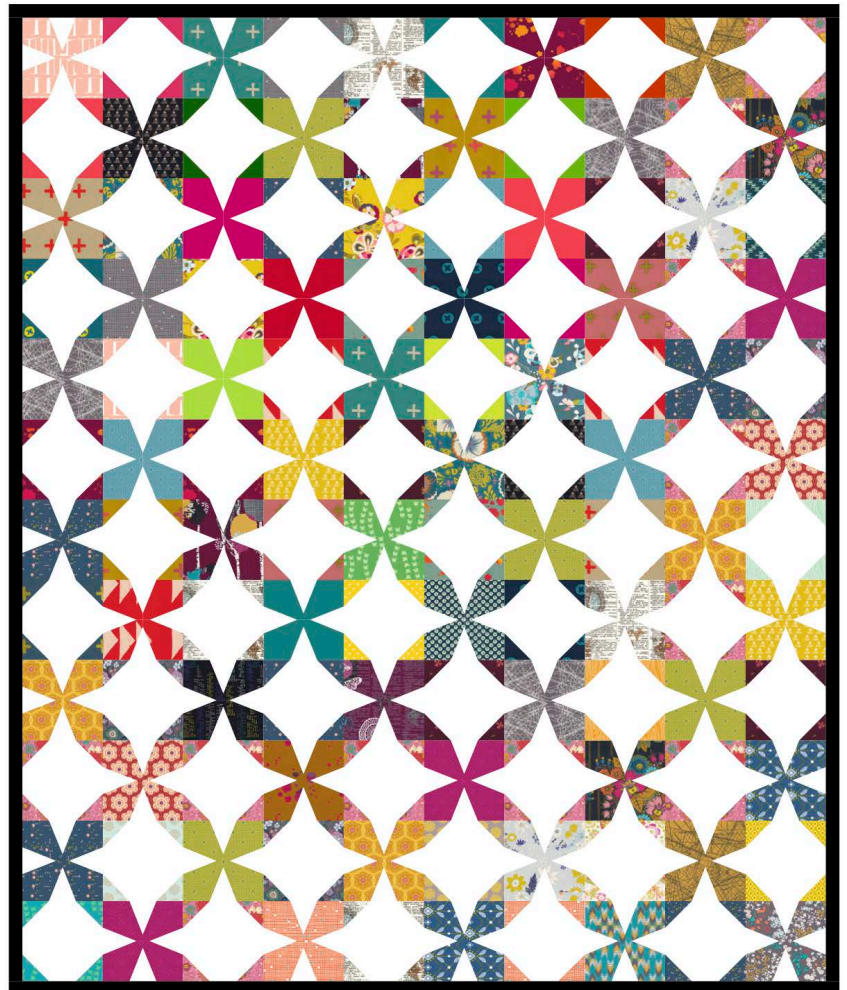
Assemble the Block

1. Sew the units together, as pictured, to complete the block.
Block will measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2".



Possible Scrappy Layout

Finished Quilt Measures: 60" x 72"
of blocks: 30
Background yardage: 4-1/2 yds
Total scrap yardage: 3 yds
